You can contact them directly and negotiate the times, for example they may just want to be dropped off at the station and collected later.

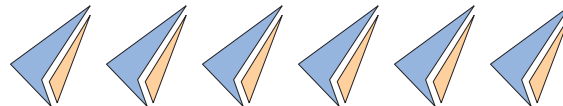
What vehicles are available?

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a car club?

It is a club which has one or more vehicles available for use by its members

Why would I want to join?

The benefits can be:

- Reduce your costs, the main costs of a car are the hidden costs such as insurance, tax, depreciation and maintenance, these are shared by the group
- Reduce your carbon footprint, most members report a reduction in car use because it makes them think about their travelling needs much more.
- No need to own a second vehicle

How do I join?

Are there any age restrictions on the insurance?

Our insurance will cover anyone aged 25 upwards.

What happens next?

- Read and sign the members agreement form.
- Complete the insurance declaration
- Pay a deposit to cover the insurance excess
- You will be given a tour of the cars and shown where the keys are kept
- You will also receive help with how to book on line using the Google Calendar.

How do I book the car?

By phone or using the internet.

How much does it cost?

Currently the charge is 35p/mile and that includes everything, even the fuel.

Do I have to pay for fuel?

Yes, the car should be returned full of fuel. You need to get a receipt for the fuel and submit it to the treasurer as credit against your monthly usage

What if I want to leave the club?

You will need to settle any outstanding bills and that's it. Your deposit will then be returned to you.

Do I have to share my car?

No. But if you would like to loan it to the club, please talk to anyone on the committee or via the contact details on the back of this leaflet.

What if I have an accident?

Procedure is exactly the same as if it were your car. If we have to pay the £100 excess then you will forfeit your deposit and you will have to pay another £100 before you can continue to use the car club vehicle(s).

Who is responsible for maintenance?

We all are, currently the person who uses the car on the last day of the month is responsible for checking tyre pressures, oil and water levels.
